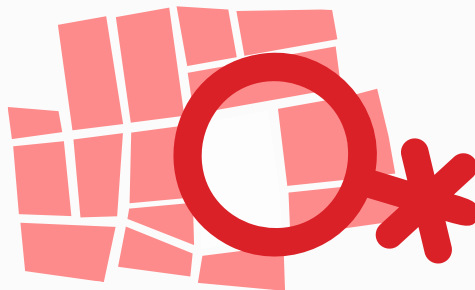

Main Goals

The transdisciplinary network **Gender and Spatial Transformation** explores the innovative potential of linking gender-related sustainability research and gender planning approaches with debates on spatial transformation.

Within the framework, we realize different events (e.g., workshops, presentations at international conferences or panel discussions) and publication formats (e.g., journal articles or policy papers).

Organisational Structure

Gender and Spatial Transformation is an international Information and Initiative Group (IIG) within the organisational structure of the **ARL – Academy for Territorial Development in the Leibniz Association**.

IIGs are dedicated to a selected field of tasks and research that has a continuing high scientific and practical relevance within spatial research and planning.

The IIG consist of 12-15 members representing both expertise from science and planning practice, who are selected based on an open call for membership and appointed for a period of five years.
